#### A. Clinics

2.

- 1. The dates, times, locations, and format of the annual re-certification clinics will be established by the State Referee Administrator (SRA) in conjunction with the State Director of Referee Development (SDRD) or the District Referee Development Administrator (DRDA).
- **2.** Recertification courses for Grade G8 and G8+ Referees will be scheduled online between July 1 and March 31 in the U.S. Soccer Learning Center.
- **3.** The in-person recertification clinics for Grade 6 Regional Referees, Grade RE, and Grade RC Referees will be scheduled by the State Referee Administrator (SRA) in conjunction with the State Director of Referee Development (SDRD).

#### B. Grade G8 Referee Recertification Requirements with three (3) years or less experience

- 1. Must register and pay for appropriate Referee licensure course in the U.S. Soccer Learning Center.
- **2.** Must complete all assignments associated with licensure course:
  - **a)** Complete or maintain a U.S. Soccer approved NCSI Background Check (18 years and older).
  - **b)** Complete SafeSport training (18 years and older).
  - c) Complete all associated U.S. Soccer Learning Center Referee on-line assignments.
- **3.** Must complete the NFHS concussion training within two (2) years of recertification (Ohio Law) and upload a pdf copy into their OSSRC profile.

# C. Grade G8+ Referee Recertification Requirements with more than three (3) years of experience

- **1.** Must register and pay for appropriate Referee licensure course in the U.S. Soccer Learning Center.
  - Must complete all assignments associated with licensure course:
    - **a)** Complete or maintain a U.S. Soccer approved NCSI Background Check (18 years and older).
    - **b)** Complete SafeSport training (18 years and older).
  - c) Complete all associated U.S. Soccer Learning Center Referee on-line assignments.
- **3.** Must complete the NFHS concussion training within two (2) years of recertification (Ohio Law) and upload a pdf copy into their OSSRC profile.

#### D. Grade RC Regional Candidate Referee Recertification Requirements

- 1. Must register and pay for appropriate Ohio South Regional Candidate licensure course in the U.S. Soccer Learning Center.
- **2.** Must complete all assignments associated with licensure course prior to attending associated in-person course meeting:
  - a) Complete or maintain a U.S. Soccer approved NCSI Background Check (18 years and older).
  - **b)** Complete SafeSport training (18 years and older).

- **c)** Complete all associated U.S. Soccer Learning Center Ohio South Regional Candidate on-line assignments.
- **3.** Must complete the NFHS concussion training within two (2) years of recertification (Ohio Law).
- **4.** Must attend registered in-person OSSRC Regional meeting.
- **5.** Must work a minimum of five (5) U.S. Soccer affiliated adult games annually (at least one as a referee on an adult match).
- **6.** Must be formally evaluated every year on a U.S. Soccer affiliated assignment as a referee at an adult match with a minimum of 45 minutes halves.
- 7. Must **pass** the Women's FIFA Referee sprint and interval test per **OSSRC Policy 2.3.**

Note: Any Grade RC Regional Candidate Referee not meeting all of the recertification requirements will be downgraded to a Grade G8+ Referee for a minimum of one (1) year before being eligible to upgrade to a Grade RC Regional Candidate Referee.

#### E. Grade R6 Regional Referee Recertification Requirements

- 1. Must register and pay for appropriate Regional licensure course in the U.S. Soccer Learning Center.
- **2.** Must complete all assignments associated with licensure course prior to attending associated in-person course meeting:
  - a) Complete or maintain a U.S. Soccer approved NCSI Background Check (18 years and older).
  - **b)** Complete SafeSport training (18 years and older).
  - c) Complete all associated U.S. Soccer Regional Referee Learning Center on-line training assignments.
- **3.** Must complete the NFHS concussion training within two (2) years of recertification (Ohio Law) and upload a pdf copy into their OSSRC profile.
- **4.** Must attend registered in-person Regional meeting.
- 5. Must work a minimum of five (5) U.S. Soccer affiliated adult games annually as a Referee.
- **6.** Must pass a minimum of two (2) formal evaluations on U.S. Soccer affiliated assignments as a referee.
  - **a)** A minimum of one (1) match must be at the Adult level or higher.
  - **b)** One (1) match may be at the Highest Youth Level, U18 or U19.
  - c) All matches to be a minimum of 45-minute halves completed by two (2) different Referee Coaches at the Regional or National level.
  - d) All evaluations will be documented on the U.S. Soccer Learning Center.
  - e) The referee is accountable for payment to the Referee Coach if the referee is paid for the game.
  - **f)** The Referee Coach for the match shall be assigned or formally approved by U.S. Soccer or the State Director of Referee Development (SDRD).
- 7. Must pass the Women's FIFA Referee sprint and interval test or higher for Regional Referees per *U.S Soccer Referee Pathway.*

Note: Any Grade R6 Regional Referee not meeting all of the recertification requirements will be downgraded to a Grade 8+ Referee for a minimum of one (1) year before being eligible to upgrade to a Grade RC Regional Candidate Referee.

#### F. Grade RE Regional Emeritus Referee Recertification Requirements

- 1. Must register and pay for appropriate Regional licensure course in the U.S. Soccer Learning Center.
- **2.** Must complete all assignments associated with licensure course prior to attending associated in-person course meeting:
  - a) Complete or maintain a U.S. Soccer approved NCSI Background Check (18 years and older).
  - **b)** Complete SafeSport training (18 years and older).
  - c) Complete all associated U.S. Soccer Regional Emeritus Referee on-line training module(s).
- **3.** Must complete the NFHS concussion training within two (2) years of recertification (Ohio Law) and upload a pdf copy into their OSSRC profile.
- **4.** Must attend registered in-person Regional meeting.
- **5.** Should work a minimum of five (5) adult games annually as a Referee.

#### G. FEES AND REGISTRATION

- **1.** All Regional referees must sign up for a clinic in the US Soccer Learning Center (walk-ins will not be accepted).
  - **a)** Must complete the NFHS concussion training within two (2) years of recertification (Ohio Law) and upload a pdf copy into their OSSRC profile prior to attending a clinic.
  - **b)** All Grade R6 and those Grade RC referees working Adult games must bring a copy of a signed Maintenance-Upgrade form.
- Annual recertification fees for each referee grade level are set annually by the Ohio South State Referee Committee (OSSRC) and are as posted in the OSSRC Policy 1.2, Schedule "A".
  - **a)** Recertification fees are included in the U.S. Soccer Learning Center licensure course.
  - **b)** All fees are payable only to U.S. Soccer.
- **3.** All Regional referees who fulfill all of their re-registration requirements will be issued their appropriate referee badge upon completion of the clinic.
  - a) The referee badges will not be mailed to the referee by U.S. Soccer or OSSRC.
  - **b)** A referee must display the current year's badge.
- **4.** All re-certification requirements (i.e. forms, fees, test, evaluations and attendance) for the New Year must be completed by the end of February; otherwise it will be considered a late re-registration.
  - a) Referees not completing all of their re-registration requirements until after the end of February deadline may be charged an additional late fee, as determined annually by the OSSRC and posted in the **OSSRC Policy 1.2, Schedule "A"**.
- **5.** All re-registrations must be completed by June 1 of the current year.
  - **a)** Any referee who misses completing any of the requirements by the June 1<sup>st</sup> reregistration deadline will be ineligible to re-register for that current registration year and will not be eligible to work any U.S. Soccer games.
