

OHIO SOUTH STATE REFEREE COMMITTEE

ASSESSMENT POLICIES

UPGRADE:

1. The official must request an upgrade assessment from the District Director of Assessment or the State Director of Assessment, after fulfilling all USSF other requirements.
2. The official must send a check (referee game fee) to the District Director of assessment or the State Director of Assessment prior to his/her assessment.
3. The District Director of Assessment or the State Director of Assessment will work in cooperation with the local assignor and tournament assignors.
4. The assessor assigned must be a grade equal or higher than the referee grade.
5. If an official was unsuccessful in achieving his/her assessments during the twelve months period, that official must wait another twelve months before reapplying. The twelve month period begins from the date of request.
6. One assessment, as a referee, must be done by an Ohio-South assessor.
7. Request for an out-of-state assessment, the SDA / SRA must be notified or assessment would not be acceptable.

UPGRADE FROM A GRADE EIGHT TO A GRADE SEVEN:

1. The assessment must be as a referee in an U19 or higher level game.

UPGRADE FROM A GRADE SEVEN TO A GRADE SIX:

1. The referee must be assessed twice as a referee on an adult first division game or higher by two different assessors.
2. The referee must be assessed as an assistant referee in a first division game.

UPGRADE FROM A GRADE SIX TO FIVE

1. The referee must be assessed twice as a referee on an adult first division game or higher. It is highly recommend that one of the assessments be a regional or pro game and that it be done by an assessor from another state association.
2. Must have two assessments as an assistant referee on an adult first division game or higher.

MAINTENANCE GRADE

1. All grade five and six **must request** their assessments from the DDA or SDA.
2. It is highly recommended that all grade seven be assessed.
3. The referee must send a check to the DDA or SDA (referee's fee).
4. The grade six and five officials must be assessed in a first division adult game or higher each year.
