Proposed Fitness Levels:

Gr5 - choice of interval test - Level 1 or professional fitness test

Gr6 - choice of age appropriate interval, age appropriate Cooper, professional fitness test, or NISOA fitness (score must be a minimum of 8)

Gr7 maintenance - choice of interval - Level 2, age appropriate Cooper, movement Cooper, professional fitness test, or NISOA fitness

Gr7 upgrade - choice of interval - Level 2, age appropriate Cooper, professional fitness test, or NISOA fitness

- 1) Level 1 8x 40m sprints in 6.6 sec each sprint, break, 24 intervals (an interval consists of 150m in 35 sec. followed by 50 m in 40 sec.) (age = less than 43)
- 2) Level 2 8x 40m sprints in 7.0 sec each sprint, break, 22 intervals (an interval consists of 150m in 38 sec. followed by 50 m in 40 sec.) (age = 43 and older)
- 3) Cooper Test (age bias) (Referee Administrative Handbook)
- 4) Movement Cooper = continuous movement for 12 minutes, 50 m in 12 seconds, 200 m in 50 seconds)
- 5) NISOA fitness test standard is yet to be determined
